Tunkuwallin Recreation Precinct Plan Development, Gwandalan

Engagement Summary

Between 21 May and 4 June 2020 Council sought community input on the Tunkuwallin Oval Precinct Plan. What's more exciting is that Council will be building a new district level playspace! The community were invited to give their feedback on how they currently use the space, and their vision for future use of the space via a survey. The questions asked were designed to assist Council develop these concept designs in a way that reflects the values and preferences of our community.

Engagement Results

Survey results revealed that:

- 50% of respondents stated that they visit Tunkuwallin Oval 1-3 times per week.
- 59% of respondents indicated that they visit mostly between the hours of 2pm and 5pm.
- 64% of respondents stated that their reason for visiting as for leisure purposes and 47% of
- respondents visit Tunkuwallin Oval for exercise.
- 79% of the respondents would like to see improvements to the amenities (i.e. toilet block, canteen,
- change rooms). 63% of respondents would like to see an improvement to the playspace and 59%
- would like to see improved vehicular access.
- 79% of respondents would feel safer in the recreational area if there was CCTV and similarly, 79% of respondents would like to see improved lighting for the area.
